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## **REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

- Parents may not register students for the North Carolina Honors Band Clinic or supervise students in place of their band director throughout the weekend. Band Directors are to be present throughout the weekend and be responsible for the transportation and housing of their students. Any deviation from this will result in the dismissal of students from the clinic after contact is made with the school principal and superintendent. The clinic chairs and officers of NCBA are not responsible for the caretaking of students. **Each student's band director assumes responsibility for his or her students for the entire weekend.**
- Be sure that you bring the Clinic Fee for all students as well as the Medical/Behavior Form. There should be separate checks for each ensemble and they cannot be personal checks. Cash, school or booster check is acceptable. The Clinic Fee is \$55 per student.
- Directors are reminded to bring your updated NAfME Membership Card (there is no APP so don't plan to use that)
- Students may not bring luggage into the registration area or auditorium. Make arrangements for this for Friday and Sunday.
- Parking is not free at UNC-CH. Please plan to park in the Rosemary Street Parking Decks. Buses will need to unload in front of Memorial Hall and then move to Skipper Bowles Drive in front of the Smith Center for parking.

## **CONCERT ATTIRE/ CHANGING INFORMATION for STUDENTS and PARENTS**

Do not bring luggage, garment bags, etc. into the auditorium. You may not change clothes at the auditorium. You must arrive in concert attire and leave in concert attire.

Middle school students should plan to come to the dress rehearsal wearing their concert attire. All high school students may change following their dress rehearsal at your hotel but may not bring luggage into Memorial Hall.

**Concert Attire** – for men is a dark dress pant, a white shirt and a tie (coat optional but suggested) and for the women either a dark color dress or nice dark dress pants and a blouse. Many students may choose to wear formal concert attire “concert black” which would consist of a tuxedo for the gentlemen and either an all black dress or black dress and black blouse for the ladies. Formal concert black is not required but permissible.

## **PARKING INFORMATION for PARENTS**

There are parking decks on Rosemary Street, which is located two blocks from Memorial Hall. There are also parking lots along Cameron Avenue that may be utilized. Be sure to read and follow all posted signage in the parking lots.

## **MEAL INFORMATION for STUDENTS**

For dinner on Friday and lunch on Saturday all students will have a meal ticket and be escorted by the Clinic Chair to the Top of Lenoir Dining Hall. *This is paid for as a part of your clinic fee.* Students will walk to the Top of Lenoir Dining Hall at staggered times on Friday for dinner and again on Saturday for lunch. Each student will receive these meal tickets from the Clinic Chair for their band just prior to the meal.

Breakfast on Saturday morning and Dinner on Saturday night is the responsibility of the student and director.

## **HOUSING INFORMATION for STUDENTS, PARENTS, and DIRECTORS**

All students are to be housed in area hotels. Directors will make hotel reservations and make arrangements for transportation to and from the campus. Directors are responsible for registering students at the Honors Band Clinic and bringing all necessary payments and requested documents. Directors are also responsible for chaperoning and supervising their students, in person, for the entire weekend.
