

All-State Audition Reminders for Band Directors

- Once All-District results are released, **get confirmation from your eligible students that they are free to attend both the auditions and the entire clinic before registering them.** By registering for auditions, they are committing to be at auditions and the clinic. If they choose to drop out last minute, it affects other students. Please keep in mind that as their band director, you are also committing to attend both the auditions and the clinic, if your student is selected.
- Since these are blind auditions, we **cannot** accept requested audition times. A random formula will be used to place the order in which student auditions
- The band director whose name appears on the class list as the teacher must be in attendance at auditions or their students will not be allowed to participate. If you are unable to participate, there are several steps you must take including finding someone to fill in for you. Please refer to Article 3E under North Carolina All-State Honors Band on page 9 of the NCBA Constitution and ByLaws.
- Please dress professionally for auditions.
- Band director meeting will start at noon on audition day.
- You are not allowed to judge any instrument that your students are auditioning on, even if that is your main instrument. If by chance you are accidentally scheduled to judge your student, please let the Audition Chairman know ahead of time.
- Acceptable forms of payment include: cash and checks (school, booster, or band director checks). If paying cash, **bring exact cash for each student** (\$17 per student). No change will be made at registration.
- Please remind your parents that only the band director can register the student at auditions.
- Please review the guidelines for Honors Band Adjudicators listed under article 7 under North Carolina All-State Honors Band on page 10 and 11 of the NCBA Constitution and ByLaws.
- Once results are released, do not share login information with parents or students.
- If a student cancels less than one week before the clinic, no replacement will be contacted.
- Any student that can not document a family or personal emergency preventing their attendance at All-State Honors Band Clinic, if selected, and fails to participate in that clinic will be banned from auditioning for All-State Honors Band for one year.
- The band director of any student chosen to participate in the All-State Honors Band Clinic must be in attendance at the clinic. If you are unable to attend, please refer to article 4C under North Carolina All-State Honors Band on page 10 of the NCBA Constitution and ByLaws.
- When registering your student for the All-State Honors Band Clinic, please keep in mind that the information you input is used word-for-word for all documents related to the clinic including address labels for music, concert program and more. Please double check the information before you send in the registration.
- Do not email clinic assistants about mailing out folders. They will mail out folders in a timely manner.
