CONCERT ATTIRE and CHANGING INFORMATIAON for STUDENTS and PARENTS

Middle school students should plan to come to the dress rehearsal wearing their concert attire. All high school students may change following their dress rehearsal at your hotel but may not bring luggage into Stevens Center

<u>Concert Attire</u> for men is a dark dress pant, a white shirt and a tie (coat optional but suggested) and for the women either a dark color dress or nice dark dress pants and a blouse. Many students may choose to wear formal concert attire "concert black" which would consist of a tuxedo for the gentlemen and either an all black dress or black dress and black blouse for the ladies. Formal concert black is not required but permissible.
