THE KNOXVILLE JAZZ ORCHESTRA

FORMED IN 1999 BY TRUMPETER AND ARRANGER VANCE THOMPSON, THE KNOXVILLE JAZZ ORCHESTRA IS COMPRISED OF EAST TENNESSEE'S TOP PROFESSIONAL MUSICIANS AND PERFORMS A WIDE RANGE OF MUSIC FROM AMERICA'S JAZZ TRADITION. THE GROUP'S PERFORMANCES HAVE BEEN DESCRIBED AS ENERGETIC, EXCITING, ENGAGING AND HIGHLY ENTERTAINING.

SINCE ITS INCEPTION, THE BAND HAS APPEARED AT JAZZ FESTIVALS IN EUROPE AND THE AMERICAS AND HAS RELEASED FOUR CRITICALLY ACCLAIMED CD RECORDINGS. THEY HAVE PERFORMED DOZENS OF CONCERTS FEATURING MANY GUEST ARTISTS INCLUDING JOHN CLAYTON, WYCLIFFE GORDON, VINCENT HERRING, MACEO PARKER AND DAN TRUDELL.

THE ORCHESTRA'S LOCAL SEASON FEATURES THEMED EVENTS INCLUDING "JAZZ IS FOR LOVERS," "A SWINGIN' CHRISTMAS," AND "EVENING WITH A LEGEND," AS WELL AS YEARLY "TRIBUTE" CONCERT.
