

#### Edgar Q. Rooker, Junior High

**Edgar Rooker**, a native of Murfreesboro, Tennessee, earned a Bachelor of Music degree from George Peabody College of Vanderbuilt University and the Master of Arts degree from Appalachian State University. He has done additional graduate work at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

Mr. Rooker's professional experience includes performances as clarinetist with the U.S. Third Army Band, the Atlanta Community Orchestra, the Greensboro Symphony Orchestra, and twenty-eight years with the Winston-Salem Symphony Orchestra. He has just retired from the Greensboro Public School system after teaching thirty-five years at Kiser Middle School and Grimsley High School.

He is currently a member of the North Carolina Music Educators' Association, the North Carolina Band Directors Association, the American School Band Directors Association, Phi Beta Mu, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. He serves on the Board of Directors of the North Carolina Music Educators' Association and on the Advisory Borad of the North Carolina School of the Arts. His elected offices include: Chairman of the Central District Bandmasters Association, President of the North Carolina Bandmasters Association, and national president of the American School Band Directors Association.

Among Mr. Rooker's numerous honors is the "Award of Excellence" from the North Carolina Bandmasters Association. In 1991, the John Philip Sousa Foundation awarded him with the "Legion of Honor", which designates him as one of the top band directors in the nation. In addition, his contest record includes twenty Superior ratings.

Presently, Mr. Rooker serves as a Guest Conductor and adjudicator for contest/festivals in North Carolina and Virginia.

#### Thomas Dvorak, Senior High

Thomas Dvorak is Professor of Music and Director of University Bands at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, a position he has held since 1979. A native of Wisconsin, he is a product of Wisconsin University education.

As conductor of the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee Bands since 1979, he has appeared with the UWM Band throughout the United States, including the 1981, 1984, 1987, and 1989 Wisconsin Music Educators Conferences, and 1983, for the 22nd Annual Meeting of the College Band Directors National Association in Atlanta. He has brought such distinguished composers as Joseph Schwantner, H. Owen Reed, Karl Husa, Samual Adler, David Amram, Warren Benson, Fisher Tull, Anthony Iannaccone, David Holsinger, and Martin Mailman to the UWM campus and, along with his students, received warm praises for performances of the compositions.

Professor Dvorak has received numerous awards including the "Outstanding Secondary Educator of America" in 1974, and has twice been presented the "Citation of Excellence" by the National Band Association for his achievements and contributions to bands. He has continued an active involvement with high school musicians, having served as Music Director of the University of Michigan Youth Wind Ensemble (1974-76), and is presently Music Director of the Greater Milwaukee Youth Wind Ensemble. During 1990, he lead the Youth Wind Ensemble in performances at the North Central Division of the College Band Directors National Association and at the National Band Association 8th Biannual Convention held at Northwestern University, Evanston, IL. Mr. Dvorak maintains an active guest conducting and lecturing schedule throughout the nation, having appeared at universities in the states, England, Belgium, France, Japan, and Canada.

He is the author of many articles concerning repertoire and composers. He is the principal author of a repertoire series for school bands entitled *Best Music for Young Bands* and *Best Music for High School Bands/Wind Ensembles*. He is active in various professional associations including both NBA and CBDNA.
